

The Ministers/Divisions/Departments shall make stop-gap arrangements, as the nominated officers are not required to attend their offices while undergoing training. Non-compliance of the directions of the Prime Minister shall tantamount to disciplinary proceedings under the Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 2020. Further, according to Rule 8 (b) of the Civil Servants Promotion (BPS-18 to BPS-21) Rules, 2019, if the officer fails thrice for any reason to attend the mandatory training will be recommended for supersession.




