Subject: **DECLARATION REGARDING FOREIGN NATIONALITY/FOREIGN TRAVEL DOCUMENTS (WITHIN 90 DAYS).**

Subsequent to Establishment Division's S.R.O. No. 893(I)/2026 dated 01.06.2026 and their O.M. No. 3/1/2025-D-IV dated 04.06.2026 all officers were requested vide FBR's Circular C.No.4(6)/S.MIR-I/2018 dated 09.06.2026 (**copies enclosed**) to submit Declaration regarding Foreign Nationality/Foreign Travel Documents on the prescribed proforma by 08.07.2026. However, a number of officers have not submitted the same so far. As per Rule 3(3) of the Civil Servants (Disclosure and Regulation of Foreign Nationality) Rules, 2026, the declaration was required to be submitted within 90 days i.e till 30.08.2026. The said date has also lapsed.

2. Foregoing in view, all officers who have not submitted requisite information so far, are required to submit the prescribed proforma (duly filled in) to their respective Secretaries of Management Wing through email given below **by the close of office hours positively** without any further delay.

NOTIFICATION

Islamabad, the 1st June, 2026

S. R. O. 893(I)/2026.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 25 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973) read with Notification No. SRO 120(I)/98 dated the 27th February, 1998, the Prime Minister is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title and application.**— These rules shall be called the Civil Servants (Disclosure and Regulation of Foreign Nationality) Rules, 2026.

(i) These rules shall apply to all Civil Servants.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or the context requires otherwise:

- (a) “appointing authority” means the authority competent to make appointment under the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 to a post that the civil servant is holding;
- (b) “foreign nationality” includes being a national of a country other than Pakistan;
- (c) “foreign country travel documents” means document issued by a foreign government that entitles the holder to enter into that country conditionally, or unconditionally, and that in future, leads to immigration to that country upon fulfilment of certain conditions;
- (d) “foreign national” means a person who is a national of a country other than Pakistan, irrespective of whether he is or not a citizen of Pakistan;
- (e) “dependent” includes spouse, and biological children, who are financially dependent on the civil servant concerned; and
- (f) “designated authority” means an officer notified as such by the cadre administrator of an occupational group or any service or cadre, as the case may be.

3. **Mandatory public disclosure.**—(1) Every civil servant shall, at the time of his appointment, submit a declaration to the cadre administrator as to whether he or any of his dependent is a foreign national or holds a foreign country travel document. Failure to make such declaration or making a false declaration in this respect shall render the appointment void ab initio and liable to termination at any time.

(2) Every civil servant, shall annually submit a declaration as specified by Establishment Division to his cadre administrator as to the following, namely: -

- (i) his and his dependents’ status regarding their foreign nationality;
- (ii) he or his dependents have neither obtained nor are in the process of obtaining any foreign nationality or hold a foreign country travel document without prior sanction; and,
- (iii) the status of the civil servants’ or his dependents’ marriage with a foreign national.

(3) Within ninety days after these rules are notified in the official Gazette all civil servants shall make a declaration in a format or manner to be specified by the Establishment Division, as to them and their dependents' status regarding nationality of any foreign country, holding any foreign country travel document and marriage with a foreign national.

(4) Failure to submit the declaration as required under sub-rule (1), (2) or (3) or making a false declaration in respect thereof shall constitute misconduct under the Civil Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2020.

4. **General prohibition on foreign nationality.**—(1) No civil servant or any of his dependents, shall seek or apply to acquire nationality of a foreign country or any foreign country travel document except with the prior sanction of his appointing authority:

Provided that no such sanction shall be granted to a civil servant or his dependent in respect of a country in which the civil servant is or had been serving on an accredited diplomatic post.

(2) In case a civil servant or his dependents are foreign nationals or holders of foreign country travel documents, and the civil servant is or has been serving in that country on a diplomatic assignment, he and his dependents shall have that status or documents revoked, withdrawn, cancelled or renounced, as the case may be.

5. **Exemption.**—Subject to provision of these rules, the prohibition and requirement of prior sanction shall not apply in case of a civil servant and his dependents, who are citizens or nationals of any other country by birth or by descent.

6. **Marriage with a foreign national.**—Subject to rule 3, a civil servant who has contracted or is to contract a marriage with a foreign national in future, shall continue to be governed under the Government Servants (Marriage with Foreign Nationals) Rules, 1962.

7. **Repeal of rules and instructions.**—Any rules or instructions, issued on the subject, in so far as inconsistent to these rules, are hereby repealed.
